  - o Ride times should be posted 9/13 on the GAHA & Foxberry websites and posted physically at Foxberry.
  - o Pagan notes: we may not want to approach a 2019 show as an "open" show, as we aren't drawing many Arabians.

- Horsemanship Clinic Talaria Farm November 10, 2018 Pagan
  - o Start marketing this the week starting 9/17/2018 with an agenda ready to post
  - o Possibly make the Horsemanship Clinic our end of year celebration?
    - The High Point program closes on October 31.
    - There is some agreement to do the Year end/High Point lunch in January.
- Proposal for a 2019 event a club member tack sale.
  - Rent a "booth"
  - Renter deals with his/her own merchandise and sales
- Can we order some club flags to give out as awards, sell at club events?
  - More information to come before the October meeting on design and price options
  - We would have to order and pre-purchase items for club use/sale.
