Program/Activity Name: GAHA Frequent Rider Programs

Date: 8/12/2019

Program/Activity Chairman: Angel Johns

Situation Analysis: In 2018, GAHA has implemented a Frequent Rider Program after AHA's Frequent Rider Program to recognize & honor those that spend time riding their horse(s). An additional category in 2019 was created for members with 1/2 Arabians and grade Arabians to increase participation as well as a youth division. The Frequent Rider Programs (FRP) awards riders for every hour that they spend riding or driving an Arabian or Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian horse in non-competitive activities. The best part of the FRP is that the type of riding doesn't matter as long as it is non-competitive! Whether you use an Arabian or Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian horse to trail ride, do ranch work, participate in parades, take riding lessons, train under saddle or just ride or drive for pleasure, you can now be recognized and awarded for what you love most.

Goals: This Program offers an avenue for members to get involved and gain awards for their non-competitive riding hours

Audience: GAHA Members. Currently 13 participants. 5 Awards or Participation Certificates were given out at the 2019 January Awards & Meeting Lucheon.

Plan: Only non-competitive riding or driving hours, logged from January 1- December 31 of one calendar year, count towards the GAHA End of Year Frequent Rider Awards. Each year in January Highest Hour winners in Open, AHA, & Youth divisions are presented at our annual meeting & awards luncheon.

GAHA High Point Program

Program/Activity Name: GAHA High Point Program

Date: November 1, 2018

Program/Activity Chairman: Connie Green

Situation Analysis: Georgia Arabian Horse Association(GAHA) has a very diverse and energetic high point program. Trophies, silver plates and exquisite ribbons are given out at the yearly GAHA banquet at the end of the competition show year to GAHA members in 32 categories. Additional High Point Awards will be given to overall winners in: High Point Arabian, High Point Half-Arabian, High Point Youth, High Point Amateur, High Point Professional, High Point Open Show Exhibitor.

Awards Champion through 7th is awarded for each division offered.

There is a point system used to calculate the winners based on placings at Arabian shows, all breed open shows, combined training events and cross country events. The GAHA High Point Award Program has been in place since 1981.

Goals: To encourage and award members to enjoy their Arabian, Half Arabian, and Anglo Arabian in both breed and in Open competitions. We had 64 participants for 2018 and currently have 44 so far for 2019. We are on track for similar participants last year.

Audience: These year end awards are for accomplishments of GAHA owned/shown Arabians, Half Arabians and Anglo Arabians in 32 categories.

Plan: GAHA members sign up before March for that years points earned to count towards end of the year award. Participating members submit show results and points are calculated for winners.

Each year in January High Point Program winners are presented at our annual meeting & awards luncheon.

Publicity: Social media, flyers at GAHA events, GAHA website, in emailed newsletter monthly. Connie invites previous participants to participants in the new year.







Any event that is presented as an opportunity for our members horses can become an "ambassador" are offered to membership first.

Winner will be presented with certificate and award at GAHA Annual Luncheon at beginning of 2019. Winner will also be featured on website and social media in show of appreciation for promoting the Arabian Horse in the local community.


